Tuesday and Thursday evening will be for playing Triples or Pairs. Teams will be picked fairly from a pot, in a jitney-style – Skip. Vice and Lead. New players will be assisted by the more experience members.

Wednesday and Saturday mornings are allocated, as free time, for members to **practice** and possibly be mentored by some of the experienced players, as well as opportunities to play impromptu games against each other.

Club Jitneys – the hold regular Jitneys (fun day club tournaments) there are typically one Jitney per month on a weekend. Food, pot luck and prizes are available. A small fee is charged for participation and club overhead.
