PLAYING DAYS AND TIMES FOR ALL MEMBERS:

Tuesday and Thursday evening will be for playing Triples or Pairs. Teams will be picked fairly from a pot, in a jitney-style – Skip. Vice and Lead. New players will be assisted by the more experience members, as a Buddy System.

Monday and Saturday mornings 10:00 are allocated for free practice/coaching sessions as well as opportunities to play impromptu games. New members are recommended to attend coaching for rules, etiquette and bowling technique.

Wednesday morning 10:00 is open for 4:3:2:1 games (individual scoring game) or individual practice.

Club Jitneys – Jitneys (theme fun day club tournaments) are typically played once per month, on a long weekend. Food, pot luck and prizes are available. A small fee of \$10 is charged for club support and overhead. Sign-up sheets are posted.

Invitation tournaments – the PPLBC will be hosting two invitational tournaments – Ladies Triples and a Mixed Triples, club members may enter these tournaments as an OLBA District 14 member. Tournaments will be posted.

Club members, as a team pairs or triples may enter other District 14 tournaments, refer to posted listings.
